

Figure Skating Coach – Full-Time Independent Contractor Assistant Coach Position

Location: Salt Lake City, Utah (and surrounding Greater Salt Lake area)

We are seeking an experienced, high-level Figure Skating Coach for a full-time independent contractor role as an assistant coach. The successful candidate will work closely under the direct guidance and collaboration of the Head Coach. Responsibilities include delivering instruction across group classes, private lessons, on-ice and off-ice clinics, while supporting operations at premier Olympic legacy facilities in the region. Head Coach will manage scheduling, invoicing, and overall skater development. Flexibility for travel between rinks throughout the Greater Salt Lake area is required.

Position Overview

The role supports skaters at all levels—from beginners to competitive athletes—in a dynamic environment at world-class facilities, with an eye toward the upcoming 2034 Winter Olympics era.

Key Responsibilities

- Deliver private on-ice lessons, group classes (including Learn to Skate and Aspire programs), and instruction across all skill levels
- Lead on-ice clinics and off-ice training sessions
- Specialize in jumps, spins, skating skills, freestyle, and related disciplines but, **strongly preferred is an emphasis on skating skills and choreography.**
- Assist with program development, coach mentoring and training, compliance oversight, and initiatives to boost registrations and skater engagement under Head Coach's direction and guidance
- Foster a positive, excellence-driven skating community

Required Qualifications

- Extensive experience coaching USFS programs from beginner to advanced/competitive levels, including group class instruction
- Current USFS membership, annual background check, and SafeSport compliance
- Excellent communication, organizational, interpersonal, and leadership skills
- Genuine passion for skating development and community involvement
- Flexible full-time availability, including evenings, weekends, holidays, occasional competition travel, and travel between rinks in the Greater Salt Lake area
- Physical ability to stand for extended periods on ice and demonstrate techniques

Preferred Qualifications

- High-level coaching credentials (e.g., Gold Medalist status) with 7+ years of experience (priority consideration)
- Experience mentoring coaches, growing programs, and utilizing harness/vestibular equipment
- Proficiency in administrative tasks and collaborative teamwork

Compensation

Competitive hourly rates with varied rates for on ice clinics LTS and off-ice sessions. An additional leadership stipend may be discussed for significant contributions to program direction. High-level coaches open to relocation are strongly encouraged to apply and will receive priority consideration.
